FLOOR DEBATE

April 11, 2006 LB 1024

SENATOR BOURNE: A call of the house is not an appropriate request. That's a motion. And if you read the rule suspension that Senator Raikes has put on there, it says without further motion or debate.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bourne, we hadn't got to the motion yet. This is to cease debate. He just was closing. Motion to call the house is in order, as we know. The question before the body is, shall the house go under call? All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 40 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The house is under call. All unexcused senators report to the Chamber. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. All members are present or accounted for. Mr. Clerk, please read the question before the body.

CLERK: Mr. President, the motion is to suspend the rules, specifically Rule 6, Section 5; Rule 7, Sections 3 and 7, and vote on the advancement of LB 1024 without further amendment, motion, or debate.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There has been a request for a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll on the question.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1606.)
31 ayes, 12 nays, Mr. President, on the motion.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The question before the body is, shall LB 1024 advance to E & R for engrossing? All in favor vote aye; opposed nay. Have you all voted on the question who care to? Have you all voted? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 13 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 1024.
