- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds for
- 2 certain tuition waivers; and to declare an emergency.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated (1) \$XXX from the General
2 Fund for FY2025-26 and (2) \$XXX from the General Fund for FY2026-27 to
3 the Board of Trustees of the Nebraska State Colleges, for Program 48, for
4 tuition waivers.

5 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2025-26
6 \$XXX General Funds for tuition waivers pursuant to the First Responders
7 Recruitment and Retention Act, the In the Line of Duty Dependent
8 Education Act, and sections 80-411 and 80-901, which shall only be used

16 Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska, for Program 781, for
17 tuition waivers.
