- 11 Sec. 3. <u>In actions brought by or against state agencies, after</u>

- 13 regulation, the court or hearing officer shall resolve any remaining
- 14 <u>doubt in favor of a reasonable interpretation which limits agency power</u>
- 15 and maximizes individual liberty.
