- Section 1. (1) For purposes of this section, debt collection agency
- 2 means any person or entity that collects or attempt to collect, directly
- 3 or indirectly, debts due or asserted to be owed or due to another. Debt
- 4 collection agency does not include the Department of Revenue or any
- 5 programs administered by the department or a school, school district,
- 6 school board, or board of education.
- 7 (2) No school board or board of education of a school district
- 8 shall:
- 9 (a) Use a debt collection agency to collect or attempt to collect,
- 10 <u>directly or indirectly, debts due or assessed to be owed for outstanding</u>
- 11 <u>debts on a school lunch or breakfast account of a student at such school</u>
- 12 <u>district; or</u>
- 13 (b) Assess or collect any interest, fees, or other monetary
- 14 penalties for outstanding debts on a school lunch or breakfast account of
- 15 <u>a student at such school district.</u>
