LB 929 amends the Special Education Act to require school districts to distribute information to parents of children, who are deaf, hard of hearing or have other conditions relating to hearing, about all placement options for auditory-oral learning and spoken language education.

It is assumed the bill may have a minimal fiscal impact for some school districts to prepare and distribute the required information, if the information is not currently being provided to parents. It is possible that the distribution of the required information may result in different placement options for children who have hearing impairments. However, any fiscal impact due to alternate placement decisions pursuant to the bill cannot be determined.

The State Department of Education will have to modify a rule to incorporate the requirements of the bill. It is assumed the department has sufficient resources to handle the rule revision.
