LB 1039 is the Fire Extinguishing Certification Act.

Under the bill's provisions, the State Fire Marshal is charged with certification for portable fire extinguishers or pre-engineered fire extinguishing systems. The Fire Marshal estimates \$6,900 in annual revenue. The cost to develop, implement and test the new certification documents is estimated at \$230 in fiscal year 2010-11 and \$130 in fiscal year 2011-12. These estimates appear to be reasonable. Since the dollars associated with expenditures are so low, it is assumed that the Fire Marshal will be able to absorb these costs with currently appropriated funds.
