LB 644 includes a summer school factor in the state aid to education formula (TEEOSA). The factor is to be .025 times the number of summer school student units. Summer school units are defined in the bill. The summer school factor is included in the calculation of formula need but not included in the calculation of adjusted formula students.

The inclusion of the summer school factor in the calculation of formula need will increase state aid beginning in 2008-09. The amount of increase is unknown because the number of summer school units is unable to be determined at this time. The bill will increase state aid for schools offering summer school programs. The State Department of Education indicates that 69 school districts expended funds for summer school programs in 2005-06.
