LB591 would modify provisions relating to territory subject to the zoning authority of cities of the first class. In cases where the boundary of such a municipality is adjacent to a governmental installation, the bill would apparently allow the municipality to extend its zoning authority two miles beyond the boundary of the installation rather than two miles beyond the city's boundary. Any impacts would be dependent upon action of a related municipality governing body to exercise zoning authority over any additional territory under provisions of the bill.
