LB 650 provides that early childhood education programs established by a school or educational service unit after August 1, 2007, may, only during the first two years of operation, serve children who are old enough to attend kindergarten. These provisions of the bill have no fiscal impact in terms of state aid for early childhood students and programs. It is assumed the option to serve these children will not cause an appreciable increase in the cost of early childhood programs for school districts and ESU's because it will be a local decision to accept the children in the program.

The provisions authorizing the State Department of Education to set up statewide regional networks for children with disabilities has no fiscal impact because the department currently has established such networks to provide services for children with disabilities.
