Explanation of Estimate:

LB 150 requires state agencies to provide advance notice of meetings of public bodies on the official Nebraska government web site, in addition to other means of advance publicized notice of the time and place of each meeting.

Some examples of meetings within Administrative Services that would be impacted by this bill are the meetings of the Nebraska Information Technology Commission and its councils within the OCIO and State Personnel Board meetings. Notices to these meetings are currently posted on the official Nebraska government web site or on the appropriate Division's website.
