LB 132 is the Abortion Mandate Opt-Out Act. The bill provides that health plans issued in the state through a health insurance exchange created pursuant to the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act will not offer coverage for abortions. An exception is provided if an abortion is performed when the life of a mother is endangered. Federal law requires that insurance exchanges be operational in 2014.

The Department of Administrative Services and the University of Nebraska indicate the bill will have no fiscal impact in terms of the health insurance plans offered to state and university employees because neither health insurance plan offers coverage for abortions.

It is unknown whether political subdivisions have plans excluding abortion coverage. If so, then the bill will have no fiscal impact for their plans. If abortions are a covered procedure, the bill may have a minimal impact in terms of reduced premiums.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 132 allows the State of Nebraska to Opt-Out of the Federal Mandate to allow and cover abortions through a health insurance exchange. There will be no abortion coverage by a qualified health plan offered through the health insurance exchange created by the Federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act. The State of Nebraska's employee medical plan does not currently cover elective abortions. Therefore, this bill will have no fiscal impact on the State of Nebraska or Administrative Services.
