# FISCAL NOTE

LB 438 changes the penalty for persons found guilty of a handicapped parking infraction. The bill provides for a fine of not more than \$1,000. Current law provides fines of not more than \$150 for a 1<sup>st</sup> offense; not more than \$300 for a 2<sup>nd</sup> offense within a one year period; and, not more than \$500 for a 3<sup>rd</sup> or subsequent offense within a one year period.

The actual change in revenue from fines imposed pursuant to the bill is indeterminate. It is possible the bill will change the amount of fine revenue received from handicapped parking infractions, depending upon the level of fines imposed. Fine revenue accrues to the local entity where the violation occurs and the revenue is used for the support of public schools.
