LB 164 would require any person moving a building or other object (defined in the bill) on a county or township road to notify the applicable local authority and electric utility responsible for the infrastructure along the route at least ten days prior to the move. The notification is to include information on the transporting vehicle, dimensions and weight of the building or object, the planned route, and the date and hours of the move. This notification requirement does not exempt the person from complying with any other federal, state, or local permit or notification requirements. A person violating this provision shall be guilty of a Class III misdemeanor.
