LB 217 changes provisions related to the Telecommunications Relay System Act.

The bill's provisions include prepaid wireless service in the grouping that is to have the surcharge added to subscribers' bills. The surcharge amount is an amount not to exceed twenty cents per line of service.

The Public Service Commission estimates no fiscal impact. The bill's provisions appear to be broadening the base of the surcharge. It is logical to assume that there could be a slight increase in the amount of revenue generated for the Telephone Relay System due to LB 217. Since the PSC estimates no impact, it is assumed that any estimated revenue increase would be minimal.
