LB 196 increases the liability limits for motor vehicle insurance policies and proof of financial responsibility requirements for motor vehicle accidents. The Department of Administrative Services and the University of Nebraska indicate the bill will not have a fiscal impact in terms of the cost of premiums for motor vehicle coverage purchased by state agencies and the university. It is assumed the cost of insurance for other political subdivisions will also not be impacted by the increased liability limits.
