LB 572 pertains to the transfer of students to other school districts within a learning community. The bill prohibits the transfer of a student, pursuant to open enrollment provisions, to another school district in a learning community if an elementary learning center is established by the learning community coordinating council in the district of residence.

It is unknown how many students may be impacted by the provisions of the bill. There may be fiscal implications for school districts to the extent the bill requires a student to be educated in a different district than is permitted pursuant to current law. No fiscal impact can be determined.
