LB 582 is the Student Expression Act. The bill encourages school districts to adopt and publish policies on student expression following the guidelines of the act. The bill provides that no student expression made in the exercise of a First Amendment right shall be deemed to be an expression of school policy and that no public school, district, teacher, administrator or school board member shall be held responsible or liable in any civil or criminal action for any student expression.

The bill has no specific fiscal impact for school districts since the bill does not require districts to develop policies on student expression. It is possible that some school districts may opt to adopt such policies. The liability protection provisions of the bill may have an unknown fiscal impact in terms of deferring or reducing civil or criminal judgments.
