LB 544 expands the topics required to be covered in the teaching of civics in high schools. The bill provides that in teaching about the duties of citizenship, specific attention shall be given to instruction regarding active participation in the improvement of a citizen's community, state, country, and world and the value and practice of civil discourse between opposing interests.

The State Department of Education (NDE) will have a minimal increase in expenditures to revise a rule to incorporate the change in statute. It is assumed any expenses related to the revisions of rules can be handled with the existing resources of the agency.

NDE indicates that most school districts are already incorporating the requirements of the bill into their local curricula. It is possible there may be a minimal fiscal impact for some districts to change or adopt alternative curricula to comply with the requirements of LB 544.
