This bill would prohibit smoking in any place of employment or public place. The operative date is June 1, 2009

The department will be required to conduct more inspections. The department contracts with local public health departments for these inspections. Contractual costs are anticipated to increase by \$25,000 annually. In FY 09, only partial funding is needed because of the June 1, 2009 implementation date. The appropriation will be funded from the Tobacco Prevention and Control Cash Fund.
