With certain qualifications and exceptions, LB597 would require that in any county with a population of 25,000 or less, the following offices must be consolidated in the county such that no more than five individuals occupy all of the offices at any time:

Clerk of the district court	County highway superintendent	County treasurer	Register of deeds
County assessor	County sheriff	County zoning administrator	Weed control superintendent
County clerk	County surveyor	Election commissioner	

Under provisions of the bill, the related consolidations are required to be in place by July 1, 2015. Based upon U.S. Census Bureau population estimates, dated March 2010, consolidation of county offices proposed by LB597 would apply to an estimated 80 of Nebraska's 93 counties. Impacts of related consolidations would vary by county and would be dependent upon unknown actions of the respective counties to achieve the consolidation of offices as required by the bill.
