LB 636 provides that a learning community is a local educational authority with respect to member school districts and students enrolled in member districts for purposes of the federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974. The bill specifically authorizes the disclosure of student records by member school districts to learning community employees in instances required by statute and when the records are necessary to evaluate programs or improve instruction. LB 636 also expands reporting requirements with respect to student data and information to be provided by the learning community to the Legislature on an annual basis.

The bill has no fiscal impact for the State Department of Education. It is assumed the bill may increase the workload of some member districts to provide student information to the learning community, but little fiscal impact for the eleven school districts which are members of the learning community is projected.

The bill may also increase the workload of the learning community in terms of broadened reporting requirements in its annual report to report to the Legislature. However, only a minimal, if any, fiscal impact is projected for additional reporting.
