This bill would create the offense of providing a bodily fluid sample containing a controlled substance.

The provisions of this bill could impact state and local criminal justice resources (courts, law enforcement, prosecutors, public defenders, probation, jails, prisons, etc.). It is unknown how many individuals would violate the provisions of this bill, and therefore, it will have an indeterminate impact on criminal justice expenditures. Additionally, any fines assessed pursuant to convictions will accrue to the county where the violation occurs to be used for the support of public schools.
