LB 716 amends Nebraska Revised Statutes Sections 14-102 and 14-219 dealing with cities of the metropolitan class.

The bill eliminates the three mile extraterritorial jurisdiction of a city to regulate, license, or prohibit the running at large of dogs and other animals in Section 14-102 (11).

The bill also provides that ordinances dealing with taxation shall not be enforced outside the corporate limits of the city by amending Section 14-219.

There is no fiscal impact to the state as a result of LB 716.
