#### **Explanation of Estimate:**

As proposed the purposes of LB975 – the Fair Bidding Act are to promote the economical, nondiscriminatory and efficient administration and completion of state and state-funded or state assisted construction projects; to provide fair and open competition for construction contracts, grants, tax abatements and tax credits awarded by governmental units; and to prohibit requirements for certain terms in construction contracts – a term that requires, prohibits, encourages, or discourages bidders, public contractors, or subcontractors from entering into or adhering to collective bargaining agreements relating to construction under the public contract; or a term that discriminates against bidders, public contractors or subcontractors based on the status as a party or nonparty to, or the willingness or refusal to enter into, a collective-bargaining agreement relating to construction under the public contract.

(1) This bill applies to construction contracts. Administrative Services (AS) Materiel – State Purchasing does not have authority or responsibility for bidding construction contracts.

The bill, as written, would have no fiscal impact on the AS Materiel Division.

(2) Both the AS 309 Task Force and AS State Building Division are involved in construction as defined in the bill as written. Neither program currently includes language in their bid specifications or contracts regarding a bidder, public contractor, or subcontractor's collective bargaining agreements.

The bill as written would require no procedural changes and would have no fiscal impact on AS 309 Task Force or AS State Building Division.


