
LB 871 harmonizes provisions for determining the financial eligibility of consumers of behavioral health services. The bill also provides for all consumers of behavioral health services to pay for services based upon a uniform schedule of fees and copays.

The Department of Health and Human Services indicates there is currently a different process in place to determine the ability to pay for individuals committed by a mental health board and non-committed individuals receiving services from a behavioral health provider. The bill establishes a uniform process and set of fees and copays for all individuals receiving behavioral health services. The bill will have no fiscal impact in terms of revenue received by behavioral health providers but may alleviate some of the workload associated with determining ability to pay for individuals committed by a mental health board.
