LB813 would provide that no county, city, or village is authorized to require any person to be credentialed to conduct business or engage in any profession or occupation within its jurisdiction. The bill further would define the term credential to include a license, certificate, registration, permit, and any other approval required by the state to engage in a specific profession or occupation. Any impact of the bill's apparent preclusion of municipal and county credentialing requirements would depend upon whether or the extent to which such political subdivisions currently engage in such credentialing, the extent to which any related fees may be imposed for credentials, and the extent to which costs are currently incurred by political subdivisions in issuance of credentials.
