Explanation of Estimate:

LB 770 changes provisions of the Nebraska Seed Law, by amending the definition of primary noxious weed seeds to include noxious weeds designated by the Director under the Noxious Weed Control Act, and removes naming specific noxious weeds in the seed law. This bill will adopt the most current version of the Rules for Testing Seeds adopted by the Association of Official Seed Analysts. These rules establish the procedures to be used in the testing of seeds for determining compliance with the labeling requirements of the Nebraska Seed Law.

There will be minimal fiscal impact to the Department.
