LB1023 would require the University, state colleges, and community colleges to waive all student fees for dependents of deceased or disabled veterans after subtracting awarded federal and state financial aid. Currently, state law requires the University, state colleges, and community colleges to waive all tuition for dependents of deceased or disabled veterans.

The University, state colleges, and community colleges will realize a loss of revenue as a result of the provisions of LB1023. The estimated revenue loss ranges from minimal at the state colleges to \$292,000 annually at the University.

Explanation of Estimate: The responses I have received from the colleges show a variation of fiscal impacts and are at best estimates due to the number of students who may qualify may vary from year to year. The best estimates of a loss of tuition & fees are: Northeast Community College - \$14,000, Metropolitan Community College - \$32,000, Western Nebraska Community College - \$33,000, Mid-Plains Community College - \$3,800, Central Community College - \$7,400, and Southeast Community College - \$12,000 for reservists and \$110,000 for war orphans.
