LB 782 requires that reports submitted to the Legislature, Clerk of the Legislature, Executive Board of the Legislative Council, Legislative Fiscal Analyst, members of the Legislature, committees of the Legislature, and a task force of the Legislature be submitted electronically. The bill also eliminates provisions involving obsolete reports, plans, a task force, and a program.

The bill applies to over 250 instances where reports are required. While the bill requires these reports to be filed electronically, it's unknown in how many of these instances paper copies of the reports will still be produced for other purposes. Also it's unknown how many instances where a report filed electronically will subsequently be printed on an individual basis in the absence of a hard copy being available. While overall the bill should provide some savings in printing and storage costs, the amount is unknown but likely not a significantly large amount.
