LB 893 provides for the issuance of Nebraska Armed Forces Pride license plates beginning January 2, 2013. The plates may be either numerical or message plates. Applicants pay an annual fee of \$5 for a numerical plate or \$40 for a personalized plate. The entire \$5 fee for a numerical plate and 75% of the \$40 fee for a personalized plate is deposited in a newly established Nebraska Armed Forces Pride Plates Fund (NAFPPF). The remaining 25% of the personalized plate fee accrues to the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) Cash Fund.

All applicants for plates also pay the regular per plate fee, which is capped at \$3.50 by current statute. The current plate fee is \$3.30. If the manufacturing cost of the plates exceeds the amount charged as a regular plate fee, then the difference between the manufacturing costs and the amount charged is credited to the Highway Trust Fund (HTF) instead of the NAFPP Fund. The bill also has language providing for the plates to be designed to limit the manufacturing cost to equal to or less than the amount charged for the plates.

The NAFPP Fund is established to support the Nebraska veterans' homes. Twenty-five percent of the fund is to be used to support operations and maintenance of the Nebraska veterans' homes, in addition to the funding normally provided by the Legislature, and 75% is to be used to support quality of life improvements as defined in the bill. The bill provides for the Director of Veterans' Affairs, the chief executive officer of the Department of Health and Human Services and the directors of each of the veterans' homes to meet at least once each year to determine how the funds in the NAFPP Fund are to be spent in support of the veterans' homes.

Expenditures: LB 893 will increase expenditures of the DMV by \$25,797 of cash funds in FY2012-13 to modify the Vehicle Titling and Registration and plate management computer systems accommodate the new armed forces plates. The department also indicates the addition of another specialty plate requires one new staff member to meet customer demands and maintain quality control. The need for a Business Applications Support Technician is projected at a cost of \$41,394 cash funds in FY2012-13 and \$42,201 cash funds in FY2013-14. Associated one-time cash fund expenses are \$2,500 in FY2012-13.

DMV indicates there are about 142,500 veterans in the state and about 15,000 active duty National Guard and Reserve personnel. So, there may be about 157,500 individuals who could apply for armed forces plates. This fiscal note assumes about 10% (15,750) of the people eligible will apply for armed forces license plates. It is assumed half of this number (7,875) will apply in the initial fiscal year due to the issuance of the plates for only six months in FY2012-13. It is also assumed that 95% of the plates issued will be numerical and 5% will be personalized.

Assuming the manufacturing cost is equal to the price charged for a plate, then expenditures by the HTF and revenue received by the fund from plate charges will equal \$51,975 (\$6.60/set x 7,875 sets) in FY2012-13 and \$103,950 (\$6.60/set x 15,750 sets) in FY2013-14. If the manufacturing expense is higher than the amount charged for a regular plate, then the difference between the manufacturing costs and the amount charged is credited to the HTF instead of the NAFPP Fund.

It is assumed the initial expenditures from the NAFPP by HHS will occur in FY14, using actual receipts from FY13. The estimated revenue is \$49,225 as described below.

<u>Revenues:</u> Increased revenue from the \$5 annual fee for an armed forces numerical plate and \$40 fee for a personalized plate will be deposited in the DMV Cash Fund and the NAFPP Fund. The following table shows the estimated revenue increases assuming 7,875 sets of plates are applied for in FY2012-13 and 15,750 sets are applied for in FY2013-14.

The bill allows owners to apply to the county treasurer to transfer specialty plates from one owned vehicle to another. The application fee for the transfer is \$3. The fees are placed in the DMV Cash Fund. The number of transfers is unknown.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 893 provides for issuance of Nrebraska Armed Forces Pride license plates and creates a new fund for fee distribution. The bill carries a January 2, 2013 implementation date.

LB 893 will require extensive computer programming to accommodate the 48 different plate configurations in the bill. LB 893 allows for 6 different military symbols each with 4 service statuses in either numeric or message plate style. It is estimated that 317.5 mainframe programming hours will be necessary to complete the project in addition to the 125 hours of in-house analysis and testing.

The vehicle licensing division has under gone considerable growth over the past few years due to the expansion of the specialty plates offered in Nebraska. These programs have been absorbed in the past without an increase in staffing but now has reached the point where the ability to meet customer demands and maintain quality control may be reduced. DMV is requesting a Business Applications Support Tech full-time position be included in the A-bill.

Impact to License Plate Program 644

There are approximately 142,500 veterans in Nebraska as well as about 15,000 active duty, National Guard, and Reserve for a total potential eligible pool of 157,500. Based upon experience with other plate types it is estimated that approximately 4,750 applicants may apply for the Armed Forces Pride Plates. The numeric plates will carry a \$5 fee going to the Nebraska Armed Forces Pride Plates Fund and message plates costing \$40 with \$10 to the DMV Cash Fund and \$30 the Nebraska Armed Forces Pride Plates Fund.

LB 893 provides for the Nebraska Armed Forces Pride Plates and distribution of fees.

This specialty plate has a \$40 fee with 25% going to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund and 75% going to the Nebraska Armed Forces Pride Plates Fund.

Costs to manufacture the plates are paid from the Highway Trust Fund. When the license plates are issued, the plate fee revenues are deposited into the Highway Trust Fund.

LB 893 provides that:

if the cost to manufacture these plates exceeds the amount charged for the license plates, the Highway Trust Fund will be reimbursed for the difference from the Nebraska Armed Forces Pride Plates Fund share.

No fiscal impact to Department of Roads is anticipated.
