LB 1133 would adopt the Redistricting Act. The bill creates a six member Independent Redistricting Advisory Commission which is responsible for developing recommended plans of redistricting for the House of Representatives, Legislature, Supreme Court, University Board of Regents, Public Service Commission, and State Board of Education.

Compared to the current redistricting process, additional costs would be for the expenses of the six member commission and the four required statewide hearings. Assuming six meetings in a year plus four hearings, costs would be approximately \$12,000.
