LB 7 changes provisions of the Open Meetings Act.

Section 1 defines "New Business" as any item not on the agenda of a meeting which is not of an emergency nature.

Section 2 provides new language stating that if a citizen speaks on an item of new business at a public meeting, the members of the body may engage in discussion with the citizen, but not take any action on such business that requires a vote at that meeting. In addition, the public body shall not require that members of the public be placed on the agenda prior to such meetings in order to speak regarding agenda or new business items.

The provisions that are changed in LB 7 are procedural in nature and should pose no fiscal impact.
