LB 917 requires school districts to revise their written policies on excessive absences to not include absences due to documented illness or absences related to deployment activities as provided in the Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children. Absences for documented illness or deployment activities shall not count towards the requirement for students to be reported to the county attorney when 20 or more days of school are missed in a school year.

The bill has no fiscal impact for a state agency. School districts will incur minimal expenses to revise truancy policies. It is possible the number of referrals of students to the county attorney's office may decrease in those counties where students who have been ill or who have parents deployed are currently referred to a county attorney for intervention after missing more than 20 days. It is assumed the change will decrease the workload of the county attorney's office in reference to these children. School districts may have an increased workload to approve documented illnesses and deployment exceptions.
