Explanation of Estimate:

The City of Lincoln has similar legislation for second hand dealers. We have a \$25 permit fee. This may broaden the definition and increase the # of permits issued. Currently we have 28 permit holders. The \$100 fee vs. our current \$25 fee would increase revenue about \$2,000. The City would incur several hundred dollars in costs providing supplies for fingerprints. This will not have a significant fiscal impact on the City.
