Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 222 requires that a variety of reports submitted to the Legislature, Clerk of the Legislature, Executive Board of the Legislative Council, members of the Legislature, and committees of the Legislature be submitted electronically.

While the bill requires these reports to be filed electronically, it's unknown in how many of these instances paper copies of the reports will still be produced for other purposes. Also it's unknown how many instances where a report filed electronically will subsequently be printed on an individual basis in the absence of a hard copy being available. While overall the bill should provide some savings in printing and storage costs, the amount is unknown but likely not a significantly large amount.
