**Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.**

LB 30 changes the disposition of fees received by the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) for the notation of a lien on a motor vehicle title and for duplicate certificate of titles issued by the department. Currently, the entire \$7 fee for the notation of a lien and the \$14 fee for a duplicate title certificate are deposited in the Motor Carrier Division Cash Fund. The bill provides for \$4 of each fee to be deposited in the DMV Cash Fund and the remainder in the Motor Carrier Division Cash Fund. The bill has an emergency clause so the change in the disposition of fees will begin in the current fiscal year, if the bill is passed.

DMV estimates the annual fiscal impact of the bill will be an increase of \$30,220 of cash funds for the DMV Cash Fund and a like decrease in cash funds for the Motor Carrier Division Cash Fund, based upon 7,268 lien notations and 287 duplicate titles issued by the department in 2012.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 30 changes the distribution of notation of lien and duplicate title fees for those issued by the DMV. This is a correction to the unintentional change when the Motor Vehicle Certificate of Title Act was recodified by LB 276 in 2005. The change has no affect on DMV cash revenues but does impact the DMV Cash Fund and the Motor Carrier Cash Fund individually. Currently the entire \$7 lien notation fee and the entire \$14 duplicate title fee is deposited to the Motor Carrier Cash Fund. LB 30 would distribute \$4 of the lien fee to the DMV Cash Fund and the remaining \$3 to the Motor Carrier Cash Fund. The duplicate title fee would be distributed \$4 to the DMV Cash Fund and \$10 to the Motor Carrier Cash Fund. Based upon the transaction numbers from 2012 changes to the two cash funds would be:
