LB57 requires a public employee, who is not a member of a labor organization representing the employee, to pay his or her fair share representation contribution to a labor organization if:

- 1. the labor organization has been established as the collective bargaining and contract enforcement representative for the bargaining unit representing the employee, and
- 2. the labor organization and the employer have entered into an agreement requiring represented employees, who are not paying membership due to the labor organization, to pay a fair share representation contribution.

There is no impact to the state or political subdivisions. The impact would be to the public employee and the labor organization.
