LB257 would change provisions relating to creation of a municipal county. The bill expressly identifies certain elements to be included in a study of governmental subdivisions to be undertaken by an interjurisdictional planning commission in the event such a commission is created to consider creation of a municipal county. The bill would also require that such a commission hold at least three public hearings prior to preparing a plan for the creation of a municipal county rather than a minimum of one such hearing as required under current law. Additionally, LB257 would specify additional elements that would be required to be included in a plan to be formulated by an interjurisdictional planning commission in the event such a commission finds it in the public interest to create a municipal county. Any impacts of LB257 are indeterminate insofar that such impacts are dependent upon unpredictable future actions of (1) county and municipal governing bodies to adopt joint resolutions to consider creation of municipal counties or (2) registered voters to successfully petition such governing bodies to consider creation of municipal counties.
