LB 499 gives the Game and Parks Commission the authority to “pass, by majority vote, commission orders which govern (a) conservation orders, (b) seasons, (c) open and closed areas, and (d) bag limits”. These orders would replace current rules and regulations in these areas. A public hearing is required on each proposed order and no order is valid until fifteen days after such order has been posted on the commission’s web site.
