LB 224 allows a preference in awarding a public contract if the lowest responsible bidder is a resident disabled veteran.

The Department of Roads and Administrative Services note that the bill may result in increasing the cost on state contracts as written, but that impact cannot be quantified. The Department of Roads points out that there is no specificity to the "preference" given to resident disabled veterans. Depending on the nature of the preference provided, the costs could be significant.
