Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 131 is the Tobacco-Free Schools Act. The bill requires public school boards to adopt policies and rules prohibiting the use of tobacco products by students, staff and visitors on school property and persons attending off-campus school sponsored events. School boards are to provide penalties for violations of the policies and rules established by the board. Notice is to be provided of the policies and rules and signs are to be displayed on school property describing such rules and penalties. Schools failing to adhere to the act are guilty of a deviation from the rules and regulations required for accreditation.

The bill will have a minimal fiscal impact of an estimated \$650 for the State Department of Education to revise a rule. It is assumed the revision can be accomplished with the existing staff and resources of the department.

The bill increases the workload of school boards to develop policies and rules in reference to the Tobacco-Free Schools Act. It is possible there may be increased expenditures for school districts related to the development of rules and the printing of signage required pursuant to the act. It is assumed the fiscal impact of the bill will be minimal for school districts.
