Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 416 eliminates the teacher education allowance as a component in the calculation of state aid for schools in the Tax Equity and Educational Opportunities Support Act (TEEOSA) beginning in FY2014-15. The bill provides intent language for the Legislature to develop and establish a system for rewarding teachers who improve their skills and knowledge, in lieu of providing the teacher education allowance in the formula.

The allowance in the formula attributes allowable expenditures for teacher education to school districts eligible for the allowance. This reduces the amount of basic funding available in the formula. Eliminating the teacher education allowance increases basic funding which results in an increase in estimated state aid of \$6,001,280 in FY14 and \$5,749,373 in FY15.

It is assumed the Legislature can develop and establish a system for rewarding teachers, in lieu of the teacher education allowance, using existing staff and resources of the Legislative Council. The net fiscal impact of the bill will be dependent upon the alternative system developed by the Legislature.
