Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 353 provides that a Natural Resources District may not promulgate any rule or regulation requiring the use of ground water irrigation to maintain a ground water irrigation right.

The Central Platte Natural Resources District notes that the provisions of LB 353 could impact the use of property located on center pivot corners as offsets to other water uses. Center pivot corners are not irrigated but are certified as irrigated property. If a portion of the irrigation rights on center pivot corners are transferred or cancelled, those rights could be used as offsets for other future uses. Because LB 353 would prevent the transfer or cancellation of the water rights on pivot corners, new users would need to purchase offsets. It has been the policy of the state in recent years to pay for 50% of the offsets, with the district paying the remaining portion. If the state policy to pay for a portion the offsets is maintained, there could be a General Fund fiscal impact to the Department of Natural Resources. The Central Platte Natural Resources District estimates that 4,688 acres could be impacted, with a potential cost over a ten year time span of \$37,500,000. Actual costs to the state on a year-by-year basis will depend upon the amount of offsets purchased and whether the state maintains its policy of paying for a portion of the offsets.

Explanation of Estimate

Central Platte Natural Resources District has had 3,750 center pivots installed since irrigated acres were certified in 2004. 3,750 pivots result in 15,000 pivot corners involving land that was previously irrigated. Our estimate is that one half of those 15,000 corners (7,500) are not currently irrigated.

Pivot corners range in size from 2.5 – 7.5 acres depending upon the center pivot. Assuming the average corner size of 5 acres, the 7,500 corners not currently irrigated result in 37,500 acres of land that was certified as irrigated but is not currently irrigated.

We estimate that of those 37,500 acres, 50% or 18,750 acres will never be irrigated nor will the irrigation rights be transferred if LB353 becomes law. The estimated impact to the Platte River from 18,750 acres not being irrigated is approximately 4,687.5 acre feet of water. If those 18,750 acres of land and water right are never used but never cancelled the NRD's and the State will have to assume that they are irrigated because they could be put back into irrigation or transferred to another location for irrigation at anytime in the future.

Therefore, the estimated 4,687.5 acre feet of impact to the river will have to be reserved for those potentially irrigated acres instead of being freed up to offset new industrial, commercial or irrigation uses.

If that 4,687.5 acre feet isn't ever cancelled out and freed up for other uses those new uses will have to buy offset water to offset their new impacts to the river. 4,687.5 acre feet of water at the current rate of \$8,000 per acre foot would result in a cost of \$37,500.000. \$37,500,000 to offset river flow impacts that have already been offset by retirement of some of the pivot corners but can't be used if there's a chance in 25 years or 50 years in the future that they water rights for the pivot corner might be used or transferred to another location.
