Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB996 would require that any state agency that receives a written request for information from a member of the Legislature, their staff, or the staff of the Legislative Fiscal Office and Legislative Research must provide that information within four business days of receipt of the request. If the information cannot be provided within the four days, the agency must provide a written explanation as to why and when the information will be available.

There could be some additional workload on the part of state agencies to meet the four day limitation which appears to be operative regardless of whatever timeframe that may be included in the information request. However, it's unlikely that there would be a fiscal impact as the bill provides for agencies to respond as to why they can't comply within the four days. All depends on the number of specific requests, the amount and detail of the information requested, and the availability of the information requested and whether it's compiled in the format requested.
