Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 826 requires the Education Committee of the Legislature to conduct a study and report recommendations for a plan to implement a career and technical education incentive program. The program is to provide incentives to community colleges and high schools which cooperatively offer a technical education curriculum by which high school juniors and seniors take courses that allow them to graduate from high school with a high school diploma and an industry-recognized credential. The credential shall be in an occupation identified as high-need. The bill provides areas of recommended study for the Education Committee as well as entities from which input shall be requested. The study is to be completed on or before December 31, 2014.

Since the bill does not create a task force of individuals outside of the Legislature to conduct the study, it is assumed the Legislative Council has sufficient staff and resources to handle the responsibilities of the bill related to meetings and reporting in FY2014-15. So, the bill has no additional fiscal impact for Education Committee of the Legislature to conduct the study.
