**Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.**

LB 884 would amend existing sections of law regarding the sale and acquisition of exotic animals and would establish the Exotic Animal Auctions and Swap Meet Act. The Department of Agriculture would be required to enforce the act; it is estimated that the existing staffing and budgetary resources of the agency would adequate to carry out enforcement functions.

LB 884 would also amend sections of law governing the reimbursement of veterinarians conducting inspections at livestock auction markets. It is estimated that these revisions would have a minimal impact to the cash flow of the Livestock Auction Market Fund in the Department of Agriculture.

**Explanation of Estimate:**

LB 884 would adopt the Exotic Animal Auctions and Swap Meets Act. The bill would require a certificate of veterinary inspection for animals sold at the event. The event organizer shall contract with an accredited veterinarian to be present during the event. The bill further defines exotic animals, swap meet and cleans up other sections of laws related to auction markets to harmonize language between the acts.

Enforcement of the Act as amended will be handled as part of the current livestock disease programs administered by the department. There will be additional cost for administrative time to handle an increase in number of certificates of veterinary inspection issued and the potential for additional enforcement work. The department plans on using existing staff to the extent available to enforce the act.

**Explanation of Estimate:**

There does not appear to be a fiscal impact to the City of Lincoln. The intent of this bill would be to protect livestock from risks (health or otherwise) by restricting where livestock can be sold by not allowing the sale of livestock (beef, dairy cattle, calves, swine, bison) at exotic animal auctions and swap meets. Exotic animal auctions and swap meets will require a permit. It may be necessary to assure that any of our local permitting is in line with state statutes.
