Explanation of Estimate: Section 1 of LB 934 establishes a new position within the Crime Commission called Coordinator of Human Trafficking Prevention and Rehabilitation. This position is appointed by the Executive Director of the Crime Commission and its duties include:

- 1. Coordinate efforts to prevent and eliminate human trafficking and provide services to victims of human trafficking in Nebraska.
- 2. Research and recommend a model of rehabilitative services for victims of human trafficking that includes input from law enforcement, social services, the legal profession, the judiciary, mental health, and immigration.
- 3. Coordinate statewide training.
- 4. Collect, maintain, and disseminate information on human trafficking and other victim services across the state, including the creation of a web site.
- 5. Provide support and oversight for human trafficking organizations that are developing strategic plans.
- 6. Provide leadership to the state in responding to human trafficking victims.
- 7. Report to the Clerk of the Legislature the results of its investigation and study and its recommendations, together with drafts of legislation if necessary.

Included in this fiscal note is the estimated salary and benefits for this position together with operating and travel costs. One-time equipment costs of \$5,000 are included to purchase office furniture and a computer. Included in the operating costs for FY 14-15 is a one-time cost of \$25,000 to pay for a study on labor trafficking. The Task Force on Human Trafficking is currently accepting bids for a study on sex trafficking but no study exists that looks at the problem of labor trafficking in Nebraska. This study is necessary so the Coordinator can effectively fulfill his or her responsibilities.
