Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 825 amends the Nebraska Workforce Investment Act and the Open Meetings Act.

The bill amends Section 48-1620 to specify that a local workforce investment board and its subcommittees is subject to the provisions of the Open Meetings Act.

Section 48-1621 is amended to specify that a youth council is subject to the provisions of the Open Meetings Act. Current law establishes youth councils as subcommittees within each local workforce investment board.

Section 48-1623 is amended to specify that the Nebraska Workforce Investment Board and its subcommittees are subject to the Open Meetings Act.

Section 84-1409 is amended to specify that all meetings of subcommittees established by the Nebraska Workforce Investment Board or by a local workforce investment board are subject to the Open Meetings Act.

The Department of Labor has indicated that LB 825 would require the Performance Committee of the Nebraska Workforce Investment Board to meet face to face rather than via telephone conference call and/or live meeting as they do now. Therefore they estimate an additional cost of \$3,808 per fiscal year.

We have no basis to disagree with the Department of Labor's estimate of expenditure.
