Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 765 amends the Nebraska Wage Payment and Collection Act.

Section 48-1229 is amended to provide a definition of federally insured financial institution and a definition of payroll debit card.

Section 48-1230 is amended to provide requirements for an employer who elects to pay wages with a payroll debit card. The employer is required to comply with the provisions of the federal Electronic Fund Transfer Act, which deals generally with the use of electronic systems to transfers funds and provides a basic framework for the rights, liabilities, and responsibilities of participants in electronic fund and remittance transfer systems.

In addition to meeting the federal requirements, an employer must allow an employee at least one means of fund access withdrawal per pay period at no cost to the employee and an employer shall not require an employee to pay any fees or costs incurred by the employer in connection with paying wages with a payroll debit card.

The bill has an operative date of January 1, 2015.

There appears to be no fiscal impact to the state as a result of LB 765.

The Nebraska Department of Labor and the Department of Banking and Finance have both indicated no fiscal impact.

We agree with each department's estimate of fiscal impact.
