Explanation of Estimate:

This bill broadens the scope of assault on an officer to include additional job classifications.

NDCS currently has 105 inmates with the charges of assault on a peace/DCS officer (1st, 2nd, or 3rd Degree; w/ motor vehicle, or w/ a bodily fluid).

The average offense sentence is 26.2 - 42.7 months, with estimated length of stay per offense (w/ 50% credit) of 13.1 - 21.4 months.

Inmates discharged in 2013 with the offense of Assault on a peace/DCS officer had an average total sentence of 56.3 -97.8 months. The average length of stay of these inmates was 37.9 months. (NOTE: Length of stay may be influenced by inmates who committed multiple offenses.)

The Fiscal Impact is indeterminable. The impact on NDCS related to future admissions is not determinable. The FY13 per diem (cost per day of food, clothing, housing, medical, etc.) for an individual inmate was \$6,422 per year.
